

Dear Parents,

Different types of languages are spoken by people from different regions, but the most important thing is that any language when spoken should be spoken correctly. The two common languages that our children should be able to speak fluently are Hindi and English. Since English is a universal language spoken and understood by people all over the world, we want our children also to be proficient in speaking it and for this we need full support and cooperation. We would appreciate if you adhere to the following points:

1. Speak with your child in English. Encourage reading habits.
2. Read out storybooks and after finishing the story discuss it with your child.
3. Encourage Word Building and Picture Talk.

The teachers are trying to encourage the children to use simple words, phrases and sentences like:-

- May I go to play?
- May I borrow your pencil / eraser / sharpener?
- I have finished my work.
- Madam, may I go to the washroom?
- Madam, may I go to drink water?
- Madam, may I come to please?
- Madam, may I go to the bookshop / tailor shop?
- Madam, may I go to wash my hands?
- Madam, may I go to pay my school fees?
- Madam, may I call the home care as I can't see from the back?
- Madam, please explain the concept as I'm unable to understand it.
- Madam, I have lost my class / Maths / fillin box / water bottle etc.
- Madam, I came late as I missed my bus.
- Madam, I'm sorry. I have forgotten to bring my book, note book, pencil / eraser / sharpener / ruler.
- Madam, I'm sorry. I couldn't complete my Home Work as I was unwell.
- Madam, may I borrow a pencil / eraser / ruler etc. from my partner as I've forgotten to bring it today.
- I am sorry for the delay.
- Check your phone about the date.

Use of magic words like excuse me, sorry, thank, please.

- When asking for something, say "Please".
- When receiving something, say "Thank you".
- Do not interrupt someone who is speaking with each other unless there is an emergency.
- If you need to get somebody's attention right away, the phrase "excuse me" is the most polite way for you to enter the conversation.
- When you have any doubt about doing something, ask permission first. It can save you from many hours of grief later.
- When you have spent time at your friend's house, remember to thank his or her parents for having you over and for the good time you had.
- Keep the classmate and wait to see if there's a response before entering.

Children can be encouraged to use simple words and sentences at home also. For example :-

- Mumma, can I help you in the kitchen?
- Mumma, can I try the milk today?
- Mumma, should I help you wash the dishes today?
- Papa, can I help you wash the car the dishes today?
- Grandma, should I come with you for a walk?
- Grandma, should I help you put the shoes in the wardrobe?
- Mumma, can I help you and the friend in the market?
- Mumma, may I take my glass of fountain from the fridge?
- Papa, I'm sorry. I was late to school.
- Papa, please speak slow to ride a bicycle.
- Mumma, may I join the morning walk in the school?
- Mumma, can I help you wash and cook the rice?
- Mumma, should I eat the salad today?
- Mumma, I will make a cup of tea for you. Please tell me where are the tea leaves.
- Mumma, can you teach me to make cold coffee please?
- Papa, can you help me find my English note book?
- Papa, can we go for a picnic today?

Wishing parents and siblings Good Morning, Good Afternoon, Good Evening and Good Night.

If we, as teachers and parents make a sincere effort and pay attention to the above mentioned points, we can help our children to learn, to understand and speak English at an early age.
